

CHALLENGE TESTS FAQs

Challenge Tests are available for eligible students to pass CSCI015 Computer Applications, MATH015 Foundation Mathematics and STAT015 Introduction to Statistics. It is offered in the **first semester** only. If you pass the Challenge test with a minimum of 60% mark, you will not be required to complete those subjects.

Who is Eligible for the Challenge Test ?

Only those students who have obtained at least the following marks are eligible :

Where do I register?

If you meet the eligibility conditions you can register by filling up the Challenge Test Application form, available with the Admissions, Academic Advisors or Faculty Coordinators.

Last Date for Registration ?

The last date for registration for Autumn 2011 is on **Monday, 12th September 2011 by 16:00 hrs**

What's the date and time of the Challenge Test?

The Challenge Tests will be held on the following days and timings for the Autumn 2011 semester

What's the Syllabus for the Challenge Tests?

Hard copies can be obtained from the Admissions, Academic Advisors or Faculty Coordinators.

What is the passing mark for the Challenge Tests?

A minimum of 60% must be scored to pass in a subject. If you obtain less than 60% you would have been deemed to have failed the Test and will have to complete the subject.

What are the fees for the Challenge Tests?

AED 200/- per subject and should be paid to the Cashier. Fees are not refundable once the Test is taken. Students will have to display their Challenge Test fee receipt in the examination hall.

When will the results be available for the Challenge Tests?

The results will be out by **Sunday, 18th September 2011**

What happens if I get 60% and above in the test?

You will be awarded an advanced standing in the subject and will be advised to take another subject by your Academic Advisor
