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

# Media and Communication

The Master of Media and Communication (MMC) explores the dynamic and rapid pace of media industries, and/or what is referred to as media arts, social media, and creative enterprises-technology in immersive environments. The program takes a cross-disciplinary, future facing approach with its subject offerings. Emphasis is placed on:

- Developing advanced skills in critical analysis, design thinking and creative problem solving
- Gaining an in-depth understanding of the social and cultural significance of the media industry, media processes and media making
- Learning to work within the evolving media landscape and how to adapt to the technological changes happening within the industry

## **Industry Focussed**

Today's media environment requires innovation, collaboration and creative problem solving. A high demand exists to employ people who can work independently from concept to completion with minimal supervision. The MMC program is specifically designed to prepare graduates for this working environment. Emphasis is placed on developing soft skills like media presentation techniques, facilitation, and project management and organisation. These newly acquired and refined skills, techniques and proficiencies are showcased in the final capstone project. Additionally, students have opportunities to network with industry leaders and alumni at program events, media events, community events, and field trips.

# **Duration of the Program**

The program will normally take you five to six trimesters to complete (based on three trimesters per year with summer as an optional trimester and two subjects per trimester). At this rate, the degree can be completed in two years or less. Classes are held from 6:00pm - 10:00pm, Sunday to Thursday, with occasional Saturday classes. Each subject requires one evening of attendance for 11 weeks.

Three study tracks for Master's degree:

**Track A:** This track covers both areas of practical experience and research. It is suitable for those students who want to become teachers or those who want to further develop their teaching profile and want to meet the requirements of the Teacher Licensing in the UAE.

**Track B:** This track is suitable for students interested in working in the broader education sector, but not as teachers, and entails placement in institutions/ organizations such as NGOs and educational consultancies/ business, etc.

**Track C:** Suitable for students interested in educational research and looking to develop their research profile. These students might already have experience in a classroom or educational setting and wish to pursue further higher education either via a PhD or a Professional Doctorate.

# **Scholarships** and **Grants**

UOWD provides a range of scholarships which offer financial support to new and existing students at the commencement of each trimester (unless otherwise stated). Whilst it does not cover living and other study-related expenses, it reduces the financial pressure ensuring you enjoy a less stressful student experience.

# **Scholarships**

#### • Academic Merit Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to applicants based on academic merit and who comply with the necessary requirements. It offers the recipients with a scholarship ranging from 15% to 25% of their tuition fees for the duration of their studies\*.

#### • Sports Scholarships - Adam Gilchrist Sports Award

This award, named after Australian cricketer and UOW Brand Ambassador, Mr Adam Gilchrist AM, is awarded to two recipients at either bachelor's or master's level, in the Autumn trimester (which begins in September). 
