

## Ignite Integrity (I<sup>2</sup>) Spring camp

### Terms and Conditions

**Ignite Integrity (I<sup>2</sup>)** is a non-boarding spring camp program that is designed to serve Campers from K-12 schools who wish to attend our spring camps on a day-only basis. This program runs daily ONLINE from Monday through Wednesday starting at 10am and ending 1:30pm, and includes morning classes, workshops, a competition, and career advice that will mark the end of the camp. *Transportation and boarding are not included as part of the camp.*

#### Morning classes and workshops

Each morning for 2.5-3.5 hours daily, Monday and Tuesday, our instructors will be engaging with the campers to work on an area of Academic Writing and Integrity, introducing them to a new skill and helping them to understand the potentials of the particular areas. The workshops are structured to assist the campers discover specific areas of academic writing, expand their interests, general knowledge and dispel potential obstacles and misconceptions about cheating in academia. Campers are expected to **attend all three days** to receive their e-Certificate of Completion and “Academic Integrity Ambassador” badges.

All instructors of the workshops specialize in their respective areas in Academic Writing and Integrity and are either researchers, professional staff or student champions at ENAI WG Centre for Academic Integrity in the UAE and/or University of Wollongong in Dubai and/or from the industry.

#### Camp Schedule\*

#### Academic Writing and Integrity Competition and Closing Day

On the third day of the camp, the campers will be able to engage in a fun-filled competition to try out their skills in academic writing. After the competition, they will be able to witness the judging process that will be tracked through a software, Turnitin. They will get academic career and preparedness counselling and given aids and materials to help them become champions of integrity among their peers. At the closing, the campers will all be presented with e-Certificate of Completion and winners will be announced. All campers who successfully complete the program and take the honour-pledge<sup>1</sup>, will be awarded Academic Integrity Ambassador badges. Parents are welcome to attend the closing and badging ceremony ONLINE on the last day with the campers.

#### Registration Fee and Space

There is a nominal registration fee for each participant – AED100 inclusive of VAT per head for the entire camp.

<sup>1</sup> Honour pledge is a commitment by ambassadors to refrain from any activity, behavior that infringes on academic integrity. Typically, ambassadors are expected to go through training, exploration and understanding of concepts of integrity and academic writing. At the end of such a program, they are expected to choose from any of six academic integrity characteristics i.e. Honour, Fairness, Truthfulness, Trustworthiness, Respect and Responsibility to pledge to uphold as an ambassador.

Please note – the registration fee is a participating fee for the Campers to attend the camp. The fee includes attending the workshops and competition from 2 April – 4 April 2024. Campers wishing to attend all three days or attending any one of the days will be expected to pay the complete fee, regardless of the number of days of attendance.

*Group discount is available for two or more students, if they register together. In this case, the discount is 50% off per student for a minimum payment of AED100/- inclusive of VAT.*

*Please note there are limited seats for the event. Registration and booking will be on a first come-first-serve basis. All fees are non-refundable.*

### **RULES and REGULATIONS**

1. Campers – all Campers attending the spring camp
  2. Camp – Ignite Integrity (I<sup>2</sup>) Spring camp
  3. Parent/Legal Guardian – any parent(s) or legal guardian of camper
  4. University – University of Wollongong in Dubai/ Centre for Academic Integrity in the UAE
- The campers and the parents or legal representatives of the student must comply with the University rules and behave appropriately when participating in the spring camp.
  - In case of serious breaches of any university rule, disciplinary and any necessary legal action may be taken against the perpetrators.
  - Campers must handle material made available during the spring camps with respect.
  - Parents and legal representatives of Campers are not allowed to enter the virtual rooms (if any).
  - Virtual room links and passwords (if used) should not be shared with anyone else. They are meant only for the registered campers.
  - In case of absence of their child due to illness or for some other reason, parents must notify the organisers.
  - It is important to respect the schedule, and especially the starting and end times.
  - Parents/legal guardians agree to be wholly liable for any and all actions and/or omissions of the Camper. Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, you shall be liable for any liability, financial or otherwise, or injury or damage to property caused by the Camper whilst at the location or if virtually, and shall fully indemnify University, their agents, contractors and/ or employees for any loss, damage, costs or expenses resulting from such liability, injury or damage.
  - University reserves the right to make rules and regulations relating to the Camper's participation in the Camp.
  - Any failure by the Camper to adhere rules and regulations may result in her participation at the Camp being terminated forthwith without refund and in such event the Camper may be sent home early.
  - Without prejudice, University reserves the right to withdraw the Camper from any activity at any time on the grounds of safety or unsuitability.
  - University and/or all its partners shall not be liable to parents or legal guardians of the Camper by reason of any representation or any implied warranty, conditions or other term or any duty at common law or under the express terms of this Agreement for any loss of profit or any indirect, special or consequential loss, damage, costs, expenses or other claims (whether caused by or negligent or the negligence of University staff/volunteers/instructors, or agents or otherwise) which arise out of or in connection with the provision of the Services or their use by parents/legal guardians or the Camper, and entire liability under/or in connection with this Agreement shall not exceed the amount of our Fees for the provision of the Services.
  - Where University provides, in connection with the provision of the Services, any goods or equipment or services supplied by a third party, University does not give any warranty, guarantee or other terms as to their quality, fitness for purpose, performance or otherwise.
  - University shall have no liability to the Camper for any loss, damage, costs, expenses or other claims for compensation arising from any instructions supplied by parent/legal guardian which are incomplete, incorrect, inaccurate or illegible, or arising from the Camper's late arrival or non-arrival, or any other fault of parent/legal guardian or the Camper.

- University shall not be liable to parent/legal guardian or be deemed to be in breach of the contract by reason of any delay in performing, or any failure to perform, any of University obligations in relation to the Services, if the delay or failure was due to any cause beyond University's reasonable control.
- University reserves the right to alter programs, activities, itineraries, excursions, age brackets, premises and personnel as it thinks fit and without notice.

- It is parent/legal guardian responsibility to tell University prior to Camp of any issue or condition that may affect their attendance at Camp.
- Parent/legal guardian acknowledge that University may use for publicity purposes and without prior notification any photograph or video taken of the Camper at the Location, and any statement (whether written or oral) made by parent/legal guardian or the Camper.
- Possession and consumption of alcohol, tobacco or drugs by the Campers at Camp are NOT PERMITTED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES. Please note that if the camper does not adhere to this condition, he/she will be removed from Camp in accordance with rules and regulations
- It is parent/legal guardian responsibility to give University information (name, address and other contact details) of every person who is a parent and/or carer and/or has parental responsibilities for the Camper. It is also parent/legal guardian responsibility to tell University who the Camper normally lives with.
- All COVID19 protocols mandated by at the time of the event by UAE government will be adhered to.
- If any provision of these Conditions is held by any competent authority to be invalid or unenforceable in whole or in part, the validity of the other provisions of these Conditions and the remainder of the provision in question shall not be affected.
